

Teaching and Learning Term 3

Term Three promises to be an exciting and engaging term for all our students. Below is an overview of the learning happening across the school this term.

Prep

English	This term students will explore different informative texts and will create a written and visual statement about an Australian animal.
Mathematics	This term students will continue to explore the concepts of addition, sharing, shape and measurement. They will continue to build their knowledge of number concepts.
Science	This term students will investigate the needs of living things.
HASS	This term students will be describing and representing places that are familiar to them and suggesting ways we care for places.
Japanese	This term students will explore the Japanese concept of Kawaii (cute) through mascots.
The Arts	This term students will create and respond to dramatic performances about their school, local community and imagined places.
HPE	This term students in Health students will identify actions that keep them safe. In movement lessons they will develop their catching and throwing skills.

Year 1

English	This term students will explore different types of procedural texts. They will create their own procedure that explains how to play a familiar game.
Mathematics	This term students will explore concepts related to number, operations, shape and measurement. They will solve practical problems and explain their thought processes.
Science	This term students will explore the properties of different materials. They will investigate how everyday materials can physically change.
HASS	This term students will investigate the different events families celebrate and how aspects of daily life have changed or stayed the same.
Japanese	This term students use language to investigate the ways in which children are celebrated through special days such as birthdays and traditional festivals in Japan and Australia.
The Arts	This term students will make and respond to drama using picture books as their stimuli.
HPE	This term in health students will recognise how strengths and achievements contribute to our identities. In movement they will perform long-rope skipping sequences to rhymes.

Year 2

English	This term students will explore the purpose and features of persuasive texts. They will create an argument for a preferred place.
Mathematics	This term students will concepts related to number, operation, shape and measurement. They will solve practical problems and explain their thought processes.
Science	This term students will investigate the uses of Earth's resources and describe ways they conserve it.
HASS	This term students will explore how the world is divided into geographic divisions and how people are connected to different places.
Japanese	This term students use language to investigate the ways in which children are celebrated through special days such as birthdays and traditional festivals in Japan and Australia.
The Arts	This term students will make and respond to dance by exploring action stories as stimuli.
HPE	This term in health students will describe changes as they grow older. In movement they will perform long-rope skipping sequences to rhymes.

Year 3

English	This term students will explore the features of persuasive texts and create a spoken text to express opinions about Australian landmarks.
Mathematics	This term students will explore concepts and skills related to fractions, division, measurement and angles. They will solve practical problems and explain their thought processes.
Science	This term students will investigate the effect heat has on different properties and represent how heat can be produced in various ways.
HASS	This term students will explore the natural and manmade landmarks of Australia. They will discuss the connections people have to these places.
Japanese	This term students use language to explore the concept of teamwork through group activities.
HPE	This term in Health students will investigate the different emotional response people have and how we can interact positively with people. In movement lessons students will refine their striking and fielding skills as they play a range of games.

Year 4

English	This term students will explore the features and purpose of persuasive texts. They will create a spoken argument to express their opinions about books nominated for the 2025 Children's Book Week competition.
Mathematics	This term students will explore concepts and skills related to fractions, decimals, operations, measurement and angles. They will solve practical problems and explain their thought processes.
Science	This term students will investigate the natural and human process that change Earth's surface.
HASS	This term students will discuss how local governments manage waste and will conduct their own inquiry into waste management.
Japanese	This term students use language to explore the concept of teamwork through group activities.
HPE	This term in health lessons students will interpret the health messages delivered in advertisements and make decisions about different products. In movement lessons students will refine their striking and fielding skills as they play a range of games.

Year 5

English	This term students will explore the features and purpose of persuasive texts. They will create a speech to share their opinions on who they think is the greatest of all time.
Mathematics	This term students will explore concepts and skills related to fractions, decimals and percentages, operations, measurement, angle and shape. They will solve practical problems and explain their thought processes.
Science	This term students will describe the key features of the solar system and explain how scientific developments have affected people's lives.
HASS	This term students will investigate the characteristics of places and the interconnections between people and the human and environmental characteristics of places.
Japanese	This term students explore the concept of personal spaces within their home environment and Japan.
The Arts	This term students will make and respond to drama by exploring drama from different cultures, times and places.
HPE	This term in movement lessons students will perform passing (shoulder and push pass), kicking (punt kick), and catching skills (taking a mark) in various game situations.

Year 6

English	This term students will explore the features and purpose of persuasive texts. They will create a vlog that presents an argument about a significant environmental issue in Australia.
Mathematics	This term students will explore concepts and skills related to fractions and percentages, operations, area and angle. They will solve practical problems and explain their thought processes.
Science	This term students will plan and conduct an investigation on the function of switches in an electrical circuit. They will design and make models that use different electrical circuits.
HASS	This term students will compare the places, people and cultures of Australia and Asia, identifying how they are connected.
Japanese	This term students explore the concept of personal spaces within their home environment and Japan.
The Arts	This term students will make and respond to dance from Australia and/or Asian countries using culture and landscapes as stimulus.
HPE	This term in movement lessons students will perform passing (shoulder and push pass), kicking (punt kick), and catching skills (taking a mark) in various game situations.
