



Dear Parents/Caregivers,

I wish to inform you that members of the Queensland Teachers' Union (QTU) at Kingston State School have advised the Department of Education of their intention to participate in a 24-hour stop work action on **Wednesday, 6 August 2025**.

As a result, most teachers will not be attending school on **Wednesday, 6 August 2025** as part of a statewide strike related to ongoing Teachers' enterprise bargaining negotiations between the Department and the QTU.

I want to reassure you that while there will be a reduced number of school staff onsite during this day of industrial action, arrangements have been made to ensure students are supported. However, students may not be with their regular class teacher or within their student group.

The safety and wellbeing of students remain our highest priority, as does ensuring that appropriate supervision is provided to all students attending school during the industrial action.

At this stage, it is unclear as to how many teachers from **Kingston SS** will be participating in this industrial action. However, please be assured that the school will remain open during this time, though normal classes are likely to be disrupted.

We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause and appreciate your understanding and cooperation as we work through this matter.
