

Kingston State School Student Dress Code

The wearing of the Kingston State School uniform is an expectation of our school community. Taking care of ourselves and showing pride in your appearance is important.

The Kingston State School P&C supports the Student Dress Code and how it assists school staff in providing a safe and supportive teaching and learning environment and promoting a school of excellence by:

- ready identification of our students
- eliminating distractions of competition in clothing choice and fashion
- fostering a sense of belonging
- developing mutual respect among students through minimising visible evidence of economic or social differences

Parents commit to supporting the dress code as part of the enrolment agreement. It is a parent's responsibility to purchase the school uniform prior to enrolment and for the duration of attendance to support students to adhere to the dress code. If you require support with this, please discuss on enrolment or contact administration at admin@kingstonss.eq.edu.au. It is a student's responsibility to wear the correct uniform each day, adhering to the Student Dress Code expectations. If you believe your child requires reasonable adjustments to their uniform, please contact the principal at principal@kingstonss.eq.edu.au.

Student Dress Code expectations:

- Plain black shorts, skirt or culottes (black tracksuit may be worn during winter months)
- Maroon collared school polo with school emblem or plain maroon collared polo
- Plain black jumper (worn during winter months- no hood, logos or prints) or school jacket
- Maroon school hat
- Black or white socks
- Closed in black shoes
- Jewellery- One watch, one pair of plain stud earrings
- Hair of natural colour



If your child is not wearing correct school uniform, a letter will be sent home. The letter will identify the specific uniform the child will need to be wearing the following week.
